Nominations for vacancies on the Board of Directors may also be made by petition if the petition is signed by representatives of 62 or more Catalyst members. Any of the following persons may sign a petition as the representative on behalf of a member: 1) the member's President; 2) the Chair of the member's Board of Directors; or 3) any other person designated by the member's Board of Directors for this purpose (provided that a copy of the

board resolution designating such person is attached to any petition signed by such person). Members are permitted to sign petitions for more than one nominee in the same election.

Petitions and signatures may be submitted to Catalyst in hard-copy format or electronically (wiseman@catalystcorp.org). Please note that if there are no nominees by petition, there will be no nominations from the floor at the Annual Meeting and the nominees listed above will be deemed to have been elected to fill the designated terms that are expiring.

GAIL ENDA. Gail Enda, a member of Catalyst's Board of Directors, is also the President/CEO of American Airlines Credit Union in Fort Worth, Texas. She has been with American Airlines Credit Union for more than 20 years, assuming the role of President/CEO in 2019 after serving in various roles in the organization. In addition to her corporate responsibilities, Yvonne serves on the boards of various community organizations.
